

What do we do?

Admissions Summer Institute is an event that NACRAO hosts in partnership with the Great Plains Association for College Admission Counseling (GPACAC). The event is a professional development opportunity for admissions professionals with less than 5 years of experience and includes sessions, networking, and opportunities to collaborate. This will be hosted in late July, separate from the NACRAO conference. For us veteran NACRAO members, this now takes the place of the New Counselor Workshop that used to be hosted every August.
